Mr. Hamilton stated that services was offered to residents in the Southwest Quadrant to change out their old, galvanized pipes and replace them with new one, they just needed to complete a survey and as of now only sixty-one customers completed and turn in their survey. Ms. Weidenof reminded everyone that the Annual Drinking Quality Water Report was out. Mrs. O'Banner stated that the report will be in the newspaper for the next two weeks and one is placed in the town hall.

Town Administrator- Joshua "Shane" Richardson -Overview Background and the Way Forward

Mr. Richardson stated that he heard complaints about S & S Disposal, where the garbage cans were left in the road or did not get dumped, he said we can give them a call. He said, the town will make sure there is a boil water advisory when the water is shut off. Mr. Richardson said he was still working with Sustainability Partners with the water and meters system. He will meet with Canfor, and they will be getting the flow meter installed from the town. As far as getting information out to the public, he will have someone check on the alerts that can be used through the phone system, and we will also be placing information in newspapers, post offices, churches and the grocery stores.
